



Hello, happy new year and here is our current stock list. Sorry about the simplified format, we just haven't had time to do the full description. You can always look up plants in Flora of Melbourne (we have a copy) or pop in and see us if you have any specific questions. Although it is hot and dry now, it will soon be cooling down enough to think about an autumn planting. If you haven't planted indigenous (locally native) plants before, they have many pluses! They are adapted to our poor soils, they attract native bees and other beneficial insects as well as birds, they need little or no water and you can treat them just like any other garden plant – prune and/or cut them back after flowering to promote growth or fit the space you have. If you leave the seeds to ripen first, you'll also get free plants!

Our tube stock is still only \$1 per tube. We often have freebies available. We are also always propagating more seed which becomes available during the year. This new stock will be added to the list, which we aim to produce 3-4 times a year.

We are OPEN Tuesdays 3.30-5pm and on the second Sunday of the month from 9.30-11am. Other times by arrangement. Please remember we are CLOSED on Extreme or Code Red days.
